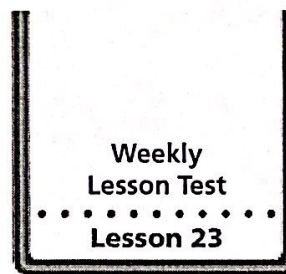

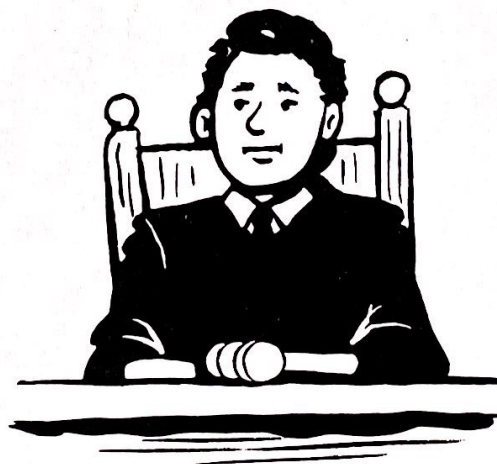

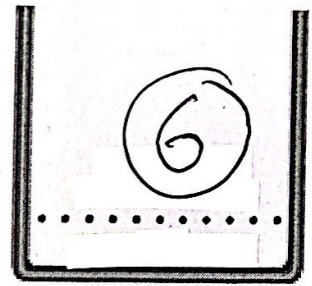

"We've made up a skit for you because you couldn't play with us today," Jessie said.

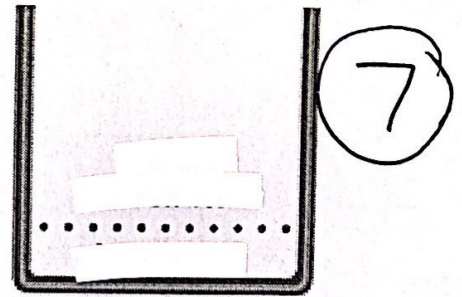
After the skit, Leah clapped loudly. "That was a wonderful surprise," she said. "Thanks to you, I feel better already."
