Ralph just wished for some Kleenex tissue, to curl up in. Ralph falls asleep.


Ralph eats the apple core and feels a little better. Two ants show up, but quickly leave.

Keith lets Ralph walk out of the wastebasket. Keith also teaches Ralph how to start the motorcycle-all you had to do was make the sound, and it rode!


Keith walks into his room and turns the light on. He immediately notices that his motorcycle is missing.

Ralph rides the motorcycle down the hall. He has the best time ever! He even drove past his Aunt Sissy.


Morning came and Ralph decided to go back to room 215, but the door was shut. Tired, he fell asleep in the hallway, waiting until Keith would open the door.

After the nap, Ralph got out of his hole and went to look at the motorcycle; he couldn't ride it because he promised Keith he wouldn't ride it during the day.


5The housekeeper came inside room 215 and started changing bed sheets. She got an order from her boss to vacuum under the bed and do a very good job cleaning.

Ralph's mom wakes him up. Keith brought them a whole blueberry muffin and a chocolate-chip cookie. The whole mice family gathered together for a reunion.


Keith tells Ralph to be a little more quiet or else his mother will hear them.

Ralph has a plan. He will take care of "room service" (food) for the family, while they are being super careful and quiet for couple of days.


Ralph gets into his mouse hole and finds his family in distress. Uncle Lester found out that the housekeepers found holes in the bed spreads and pillow cases.

After diner, Keith's parents come to his room. Mrs. Gridley worries about Keith, but Mr. Gridley just gives him a glass of water and then they went to their room.



Ralph tells his family that he will go outside to look for an aspirin tablet. Everybody worries about Ralph.


Betty and Mary Lou love the idea of taking Ralph into their classrooms as a classroom pet.

Ralph leaves the aspirin tablet near the elevator, then goes and wakes up Keith. He takes an ambulance car and purposefully wakes up the dog in room 211.


Ralph uses the elevator to go get the aspirin and back up to the second floor. He puts it inside the ambulance and drives to room 215.
